**2018 AGRICULTURE SCHOLARSHIP AWARD**

The Walker County Soil and Water Conservation District (SWCD) will grant a \$1,000 scholarship for 2018 graduating seniors. Deadline to file application: **April 30, 2018**

**Scholarship Applicant Eligibility Requirements**

- High School Senior
- Walker County Resident
- Graduating from an accredited high school or home school program
- Pursuing studies in *Agricultural or related Life Science studies*
- Award winners must make application to enroll in a two or four year college as a full time student with a minimum of 12 hours per semester.

**To apply for Scholarship submit the following:**

- Completed scholarship application
- High school transcript with current rank in class
- Letter of recommendation
- *On an attached sheet, write in your own words in your own handwriting a composition about yourself and your goals for the future (approximately one page in length). You may include information about your interest, hobbies, plans for the future, family, ambitions or whatever you choose.*
- **Submission Deadline: April 30, 2018**

Selection will be based on academic merit, recommendations of the school and others concerning the applicant's initiative, character, leadership, citizenship and need. All scholarship applicants will be notified by **May 4, 2018** of the District's selection.

The scholarship funds will be issued after proof of registration has been submitted to the Walker County SWCD. *The scholarship funds awarded must be used within one year of issue date.* It is the responsibility of the scholarship recipient to notify this office of the address of the Financial Aid Office of the institution they will attend. Scholarship funds may be issued to the institution or the student. Applicants must register and attend classes the fall semester after receiving the scholarship.
